### PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

**Pro-Joint Tape SA** is a laminated non-woven fleece backed butyl tape suitable for overlaying with liquid waterproofing systems.

The adhesive surface is protected by a silicone coated release liner with finger lift edges for easy backing removal and adheres to all difficult porous or non-porous surfaces.

## **APPLICATION**

- Concrete
- Metal

**Pro-Joint Tape SA** is appropriate for the following applications prior to the use of liquid waterproofing systems:

- Joints and seams on roofing surfaces
- Sealing joints on insulation boards, outlets, and details
- Cut edge corrosion work on sheet metal
- Sealing exposed cut edges
- Sealing between sheets

### INSTALLATION

### Surface preparation

- Repair substrate defects such as holes, voids, tears, and cracks, using suitable materials
- All loose and friable material must be removed by mechanical means where necessary
- Oil, dust, and debris should be removed by brush and vacuum
- Any defective or decayed areas of the substrate or insulation should be cut out, repaired, and reinstated to provide a solid base
- Surfaces should be sound, clean, dry, free from defects, visible dampness, fungal growth, and corrosion
- Adhesion tests may be required to confirm substrate suitability before installation
- When applying the tape to porous or friable surfaces, it is recommended that the surface be treated with Pro-Prime® SA to seal and stabilise the surface

#### Installation method

- Remove the release paper and apply the tape to the substrates to be joined
- Take care to avoid rucks in the tape
- Roll the tape with a small roller to ensure good adhesion along the whole length of the tape
- Application temperature 5 30 °C
